B. The *Progress Pride* flag expands the Pride Flag to explicitly include people of color, plus trans and intersex folks.

C. The *Transgender Flag* uses "traditional" boy and girl colors, with space for those who identify as neither.

D. The symbolism on the *Intersex Flag* represents completeness.

E. The *Bisexual Flag* symbolizes same-gender attraction, opposite-gender attraction, and their overlap.

F. The *Asexual Flag* actually represents asexuality, greysexuality, sexuality, and community.

G. The *Polyamory Flag* uses symbolism that represents infinite possibilities.

H. The *Lesbian Flag's* stripes represent ideas ranging from gender non-conformity to community to traditional femininity.

I. The *Aromantic Flag* has symbolism representing friendship and "the opposite of romance."
